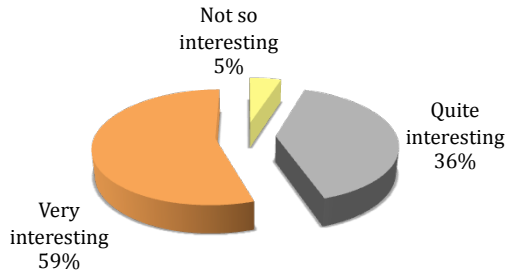


## 8<sup>th</sup> EuroAfrica-ICT Concertation Meeting – Post event survey results

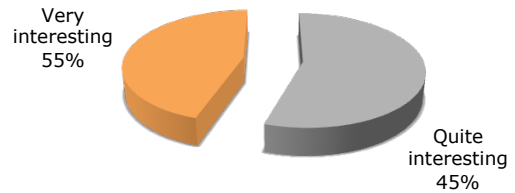
Number of surveyed people: 73 / Number of received answers: 32

### How would you globally assess the interest you have found participating in this event?



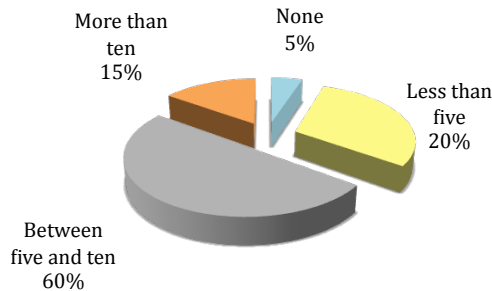
95 % of participants have found the event very interesting or quite interesting.

### How would you assess the overall quality of the meeting agenda?



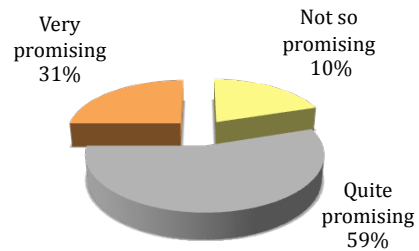
All the participants have found the meeting agenda very interesting or quite interesting, as a proof of the fact that the event has met the participants' expectations.

### How many useful contacts have you established or strengthened during the meeting?



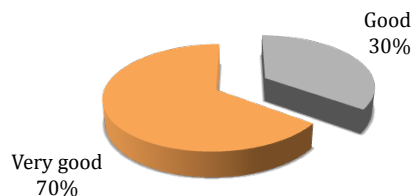
The meeting has been very fruitful in terms of networking: the majority of participants has established between five and ten useful contacts (some of them more than ten) while only the 25% of them established or strengthened less than five contacts (or none).

### Do you feel after the event that cooperation between Europe and Africa on ICT research is..



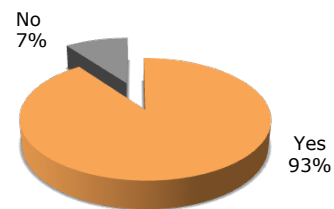
The majority of participants feel that cooperation between Europe and Africa is promising. However, the 10% have a more negative view.
